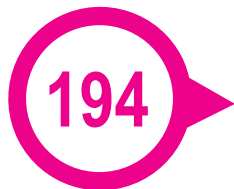

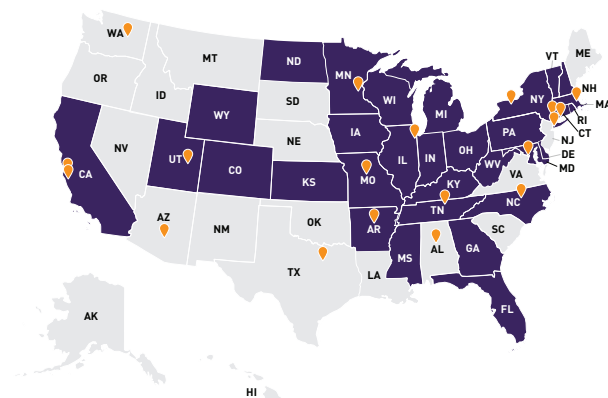

## WE MADE PROGRESS IN DIAGNOSIS AND CARE



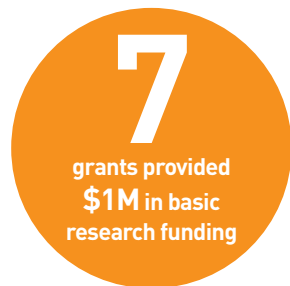
### 19 SITES IN OUR CURE SMA CARE CENTER NETWORK

Our outreach efforts continue in order to ensure all states have the resources needed to implement newborn screening for SMA.

## WE INVESTED IN AND SUPPORTED RESEARCH



We are investing in new basic research to expand SMA treatment options, including non-SMN therapies, so every individual affected by SMA has the best choices available.



We continue to expand our Clinical Trial Readiness Program in the U.S. to manage more complicated clinic trials in SMA. This includes PT and CRC workshops, trial readiness toolkits, and an online hub with resources to support clinical research staff.
