This list of resources is meant to guide you in finding transportation services while at the 2025 Annual SMA Conference. The information here is mostly specific to travel in and out of John Wayne Airport (SNA), Long Beach Airport (LGB), Ontario (ONT), and Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). To ensure up to date information, we recommend you call companies directly to make your arrangements. Please note: Due to the high demand for wheelchair accessible transportation to and from conference, if you or your child are using a manual chair and are able to transfer from the chair and stow it while in transit, consider utilizing a van or SUV service to allow for the shuttles and vehicle with lifts and ramps to be available for those who are unable to transfer. Thank you!

time, depending on the vehicle.

Note: Prices are approximations. Only 3 full size vans available with capacity for 1 wheelchair and up to 5 passengers. No more than 6 luggage items allowed. To make a reservation, call or email.

Details:

EVE routes are available in Anaheim and are operated by Anaheim Regional Transportation (ART), so they are ONLY from SNA Airport. The routes will connect you from SNA directly to Disneyland Hotel. Download the app (link to do so is on the website.) One way is \$7.50/person.

Note: Can take up to 2 more passengers for a fee of \$20 per additional person. Luggage needs will need to be discussed when booking appointment to ensure there is space. It is best to call to book (versus booking on the website).

Details: There are a limited number of

accessible taxis available so call the day prior to your flight arriving/departing to book pick up.

WAV (wheelchair accessible vehicles) are sometimes available, depending on availability. To check, you will need to attempt to book your ride ahead of time on the Uber or Lyft apps (or check upon arriving, but note that there may not be accessible vehicles available.)

Details: They have 4 accessible vehicles available for rent. Rate is \$150 per day (plus tax). Rental includes 100 free miles per day. Facility is 19 miles from John Wayne (SNA) airport, 12 miles from Long Beach Airport (LGB), and 30 miles from LAX, and 42 miles from Ontario (ONT) airport, but renter must come to facility to pick up van. Renter must have full insurance that covers of vehicle and conversion - call to discussed requirements.

Details:

Company rents accessible vans that have space for 1 wheelchair plus 5 passengers and luggage. There is a 10% discount for first time renters.

LAX delivery only: 5-day rental rate is \$139/day plus taxes and fees.

Vehicle can be delivered to airport but only for at least a 3-day rental.

Delivery fee is: \$75 each way for LAX

Delivery arrangements may be available for SNA or LBG airports, but call to confirm if this is an an option. \$500 deposit for incidentals is required to make reservation (ran 1-2 days prior to pick-up). Funds are held on card and released back to card on the last day of rental. Cost of rental is due upon making reservation. Full insurance and licenses required. *Note that up to 3 authorized drivers can be put on reservation.

All locations: 3-6 day estimated rate is \$160 per day plus tax. Airport delivery is \$200.00 one-way at LAX, LGB and SNA: \$150 one-way delivery fee.

To book service through SNA or LGB location, contact Tammy at - 951-686-3152.

To book service through LAX location, contact Alicia at the Pasadena location at 626-584-8181 Call as soon as possible to reserve.

Note: *Mobility Works will give a 10% discount if more than four rentals are made via conference attendees. The logistics of this will not be arranged by Cure SMA, but if you know three or more families or individuals who are looking to rent a van, you can contact Tammy at the number above and she will apply a 10% discount to your rental charges.
