**Please note:** Due to the high demand for wheelchair accessible transportation to and from conference, if you or a family member are using a manual chair and are able to transfer from the chair and stow it while in transit, consider utilizing a van or SUV service to allow for the shuttles and vehicle with lifts and ramps to be available for those who are unable to transfer. Thank you!  
\*Note that all companies listed below offer non-accessible options as well, except Comfort Ride.

## Shuttle & Direct Transportation Companies

### Mears Connect

\*Mears is the company who previously ran the Magical Express Shuttle so they are familiar with accessible transportation and have many years of experience.

**Details:** Mears Connect is an affordable option, with wheelchair accessibility on all buses. Cost is free for children under 3, \$13 for 3 - 9 years old, and \$16 for 10+ years, one way. You can reserve ahead of time online. When you do, if you need to stay in your wheelchair while traveling, you can note this in your reservation. Call directly with any questions you have about accommodations. They also offer "Express Service" with a more direct route. Cost is \$250 round trip.

### MCO2Disney by ATC

**Details:** Book online to choose dates of travel and to indicate what type of vehicle is needed, including ADA vehicles. for price details, vehicle options, and to book. Accessible vans that can accommodate one wheelchair user are between \$200 - \$250 one way, but do allow for up to 12 passengers so if choosing to book, consider carpooling with other conference attendees to cut down on cost.

**Details:** Use website to book or call. Accessible vans are approximately \$138 one way. Non-accessible shuttle service to Orlando resorts for \$40 per person, one way.

### REMEMBER!

#### BOOK SOONER RATHER THAN LATER

*With so many conference attendees needing accessible transportation, it's best to make arrangements ASAP.*

#### ALWAYS BEST TO DOUBLE CHECK

*Even when online booking is available, it is good practice to call a few days prior to your reservation to confirm all needed accommodations are in place.*

**Details:** For more information, call the number above or you can fill out a form on the website to be contacted by a representative of the company to help you schedule your trip. One way cost is \$154 and vehicles can accommodate one wheelchair user. They do a vehicle that can hold more than one wheelchair space, but the cost is \$324 one way.

## Public Transportation

### LYNX

**Details:** LYNX is Orlando's public bus system. It will take the most amount of time but is a very inexpensive option if you have the time and do not have a lot of medical equipment and luggage you're traveling with. Use the link above to find apps to plan your trip or use Google Maps.

## Accessible Taxi Company

### Yellow Cab (run by Mears)

**Details:** Approximate price one way from MCO to Yacht & Beach Club Resorts is \$75

Can fit 4 individuals + a wheelchair user

Per the company, pre-scheduled pick ups are not available from the airport because there are designated Yellow Cab pick-up spots near baggage claim/ground transportation in each terminal. Go to the pick-up spot and request a wheelchair accessible vehicle and one will be called. Call the number above if you'd like to confirm details.

## Rideshare - Uber & Lyft

### Uber & Lyft

**Details:** WAV (wheelchair accessible vehicles) are sometimes available. To check availability, you will need to attempt to book your ride ahead of time (or upon arriving) on the Uber or Lyft apps.

## Accessible Van Rentals

Accessible van rentals are often more expensive than other transportation options but if you plan to sightsee other than Disney, this may be an option you'd like to explore.
